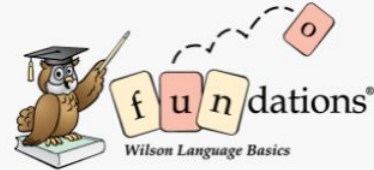
# ***Birthdays and Celebrations***

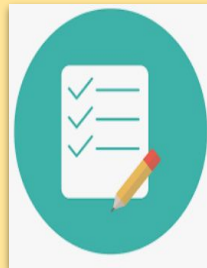

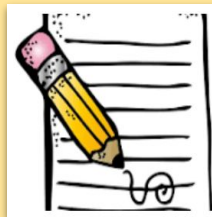
# About our Classroom

Please check and clean out home folders each night.

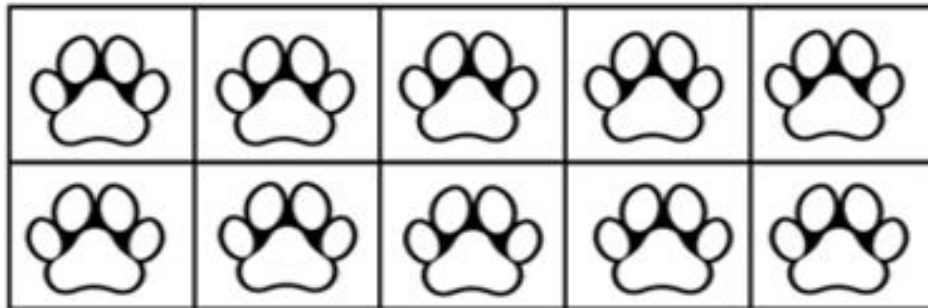


## Homework
