The vowel is a short sound. (ex. cat, ask)<br><b>Vowel Teams</b> - Two vowels together that make one sound. (ai, ay, ee, ea, ey, oi, oy)<br><b>Foundations Words</b> click, chunks, sniffs, rust, test, dress, puffs, class, frogs, plugs, steps, dents, lunch, Fran, drill, ponds<br><b>Trick Words</b> - say, says, see, between, each |
