

Insurance & Medical Assistance:

Affordable Care Act - 1-800-318-2596 or www.healthcare.gov

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) provides affordable health insurance for New Jersey residents.

NJ Family Care – 1-800-701-0710 or www.njfamilycare.org

New Jersey's publicly funded health insurance program - includes CHIP, Medicaid and Medicaid expansion populations. That means qualified NJ residents of any age may be eligible for free or low cost health insurance that covers doctor visits, prescriptions, vision, dental care, mental health and substance use services and even hospitalization.

Financial Assistance:

Low Income Energy Assistance (LIHEAP) - 1-800-510-3102

The Home Energy Assistance Program provides helps low-income residents with their heating & cooling bills, makes provisions for emergency heating system services and emergency fuel assistance.

Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) – 1-888-895-8179 or <u>www.njeitc.org</u> EITC is a federal and state tax credit benefit for individuals and families who earn low-to-moderate income in NJ.

Social Services for the Homeless (SSH)

Provides assistance to New Jersey residents who are at risk of homelessness, but are eligible for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Welfare (TANF), General Assistance Welfare (GA), or Supplemental Security Income (SSI).

New Jersey Children's System of Care (CSOC) – 1-877-652-7624

The New Jersey Children's System of Care (CSOC), formerly the Division of Child Behavioral Health Services, serves children and adolescents with emotional and behavioral health care challenges and their families; children with developmental and intellectual disabilities and their families; and, children with substance use challenges and their families. CSOC is committed to providing services based on the needs of the child and family in a family-centered, community-based environment.

Early Intervention Services (under the age of 3) – 1-800-653-4463

This resource provides screening, evaluation, and intervention services for children ages' birth to the age of three years old that present with possible language, motor, or cognitive delays.

Glassboro Head Start - 856-307-2299

Head Start is a federal program that promotes the school readiness of children ages birth to five from low-income families by enhancing their cognitive, social, and emotional development.

New Jersey Child Care Help Line – 1-800-332-9227

The Child Care Help Line helps connect families to the local childcare resource and referral team to help determine if families are eligible for subsidies from the State of New Jersey.

New Jersey Child Abuse Hotline – 1-877-NJ ABUSE (652-2873)

The Child Abuse Hotline receives all reports of child abuse and neglect 24-hours a day, 7-days a week. Reports requiring a field response are forwarded to a DCP&P Local Office for investigation.

The Division of Child Protection and Permanency (DCP&P) -

DCP&P is New Jersey's child protection and child welfare agency within the Department of Children and Families. Its mission is to ensure the safety, permanency and well-being of children and to support families.

2NDFLOOR is a confidential and anonymous helpline for New Jersey's youth and young adults. Youth are provided with solutions and resources for the problems they face at home, at school or at play. Youth who use this service receive quality service, support, and information from trained counselors, volunteers and interns. Counselors are available to help youth make healthy decisions and find solutions to various issues they face such as: peer relationships, bullying, mental health issues, dating, sex/sexuality issues, etc. Services include a 24/7 helpline, interactive website with an online message board, and text support.
