

Insects

Concepts:

- 1. Identify what student knows about insects and wants to learn
- 2. Identify and describe parts of an insect (3 body segments, 6 legs, wings, antenna, etc.)
- 3. Give examples of where and how insects live (hives, trees, underground or colonies, flowers, under rocks, anthills, migration, camouflaging, etc.)
- 4. Identify and describe the types of insects that are in our environment (ants, flies, caterpillars) and those that are not (scorpions, etc)
- 5. Describe how insects change (metamorphosis, caterpillars to butterflies, stages, etc.)
- 6. Identify types of jobs that work with insects: gardeners, exterminators, beekeepers, entomologists, etc.)
- 7. Understand how insects help the earth through decomposition and pollination

Vocabulary for Insect Study:

Applying and Extending Learning:

Dramatic Play-encourage child to act out different sounds and motions of insects and act out careers associated with insects such as beekeepers and exterminators Fine Arts-Use materials around the house to create your own insects such as toilet paper rolls, tin foil, coins, rocks, paper, silverware, blocks, etc.

Discovery/Science-Go on a bug hunt in the yard and look for bugs in different habitats such as under rocks, in sand, in trees, etc. Try to identify the types of bugs. Draw the bugs on paper and create a chart to keep track of the number and types of bugs.

Music/Movement-Dance to music; imitating insects

Technology: View webcasts showing different insects in the habitats and life cycles, take a virtual field trip to visit a beekeeper or entomologist, listen to and read books about Insects (see book list and/or visit school website for recorded Read Alouds)

Using a magazine or newspaper, play "I Spy" the letters of their name. Circle all the letters they find. what was the most popular?	Count to 10. Challenge: try to hop on one foot to 10, do 10 jumping jacks, balance on the other foot for 10 seconds.	Do a variety of puzzles wooden and cardboard. After complete hide one piece and play "what's missing.	Tear Scrap paper to make a collage. Have your child tell you what they made and you can write a sentence about it.	Rainbow write your name. Use lots of colors to trace over your name until it looks like a rainbow.
Play games or explore with tweezers or small tongs to pick up small items such as cotton balls, marshmallows, or small rocks.	Find big, medium and small words in a book. Parents make a list and students clap out the syllables of each word.	Roll out playdough flat to make shapes, letters, and numbers. Let your child make their name out of playdough.	Lather shaving cream on the tub wall and practice making letters, shapes and numbers in the shaving cream. Practice writing their name, too.	Read a book to your child and have them turn the pages and retell you their favorite part of the story.
Using connecting markers, connect them and measure how tall each person in the family is. Who is the tallest/shortest?	Trace objects or use tracing stencils. Try to trace using broken crayons, short colored pencils or thin markers.	Draw a picture of your family and label all the people in your family picture.	Go on a letter hunt in your home. Notice and talk about all the letters you see! What letter was the most popular letter?	Go on a circle and Square hunt in your kitchen. Count how many you can find of each shape.
USe small marshmallows and toothpicks to make shapes. Challenge: See if they can make a 3D shape like a box (cube).	Trace out our child's foot and cut the foot out. Use the foot to measure how many "kid" feet big objects around the house are. Ex. their bed.	Make a pattern using coins, blocks, or any small objects. Draw your pattern and bring to school to share.	Create a menu for dinner or a special occasion. Have your child set the table, too. Count all the plates, spoons, napkins and cups.	Read a rhyming book and encourage your child to fill in the rhymes in the book. Brainstorm more rhyming words.
Go on a nature walk. Collect twigs, leaves, nuts. Sort and count how many of each. While outside look at your shadow (is it taller or shorter than you?)	Have your child "read the pictures" of a book. Have them make up a completely new story just using the pictures.	Read in a fun place like the bathtub, under covers, under a tree or park. For fun use a flashlight to read.	water play: fill up a small dish pan and have your child explore the water with eye droppers, sponges, different size containers and objects for sinking and floating.	Sprinkle salt, flour, oatmeal or sand onto a cookie sheet. Let your child practice letters, shapes and numbers.



Caterpillar Patterning


Pictures of caterpillars with different types of patterns , for children to recreate. They could recreate the pattern with LEGO blocks, pompoms and sorters.




Memory Game - Insects & Crawlers
