## GLASSBORO ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME 1994 INDUCTEES

JOSEPH ANSTATT - Class of 1958, a fine three sport athlete, Joe earned varsity letters in football basketball and baseball. He was the football team captain and a leader in the school as well, elected to be the Senior Class President. Joe was a hard running back and an outstanding linebacker. He caught the attention of college coaches and earned a scholarship to Rutgers University. He presently resides in North Jersey

**GLASSBORO ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME  
1994 INDUCTEES**

**WILLIAM HILL** - Class of 1939, a three sport performer excelling in football, baseball and track. In football he was a rugged offensive and defensive end; an outfielder in baseball; and competed in the 100 yd. and 200 yd. dashes and high jump in track. Following graduation, he entered the U.S. army, serving in Europe and the Pacific during World War II. He retired from Mobil Oil Company, Paulsboro, in 1986 with 46 years of service. He resides in Woodbury.

**JESSIE HARDEN** - Class of 1941, another outstanding football player in the early 40's, he was a fullback on offense and a linebacker on defense. He and Tom Fanfarillo made Glassboro's single-wing offense almost unstoppable and one of the most exciting in South Jersey. Following high school he entered the U.S. Army, serving in Europe during World War II. he retired from the Command Co., Inc., Folsom, in 1985. He and his wife Frances still reside in Glassboro.

**ROBERT HILL** - Class of 1943, a two sport performer excelling in football and baseball. In football, he was elected captain in his senior year, and was a pulling guard on offense and a noseguard on defense. In baseball he was an outfielder. Following high school, he entered the U. S. Coast guard. he retired from Mobil Oil Company, Paulsboro, in 1985 with 38 years of service. He resides in Woodbury.

**SAM TRIFILETTI** - Class of 1939, Sam earned his varsity letters as a hard nosed lineman on the football team. But it is Sam's contributions to Glassboro that have earned him a spot on the Hall of Fame. He served as a midget coach for many years, served a long term on the Board of Education and founded the Glassboro Hall of Fame and has served as the Chairman for the past twenty years helping to induct more than a hundred former athletes in the Hall of Fame.

**ROBERT VIDEN** - Class of 1933, another versatile athlete, Bob earned letters in track, baseball and football. In football he was a halfback, team leader and Captain on a team that compiled a two year record of 16 wins against only 2 losses. He retired from Owens Illinois after 40 years of service and now helps his son manage Bob's Little Sports shop here in Glassboro.

**PAUL LEE** - Class of 1953, another outstanding three sport performer, Paul earned nine varsity letters in wrestling, baseball and football. He was a starter for three years on our football team that combined for a three year record of 15 wins and only 5 losses. In wrestling he was one of the top wrestlers in South Jersey and a fine catcher on the baseball team. Paul currently is a teacher for Clearview Regional.
