



Sam Laspata, Jr. ranks third in victories at Glassboro High School with a career record of 94-12-3. The 1988 araduate was undefeated as a senior, finishing 34-0-0, and was named All District 29, 1st Region 8, 1st State at 140 and 1st Team All-South Jersey. An All-Tri-County Conference selection for all four years, he helped the Bulldogs reach a 50-23 record from 1984-88. Laspata won his 109th and final high school match in a 4-3 decision over Rob Meehan of Paramus to win the state title in March, 1988.

Stellar ability and accomplishment followed Laspata to George Mason University where he competed for three years, finishing with a collegiate record of 35-13-1. In his junior year, Laspata was named Connection Newspapers/ GMU Athlete of the Week for winning all four matches in the1991 Navy Classic wrestling tournament in Annapolis, MD. He helped GMU to a fifth place overall finish in the tournament, and became the first George Mason wrestler to win a championship in the event. As a GMU freshman, he

Basketball standout Kevin Timbers has the distinction of being the only Glassboro High School graduate to hold a New Jersey State Championship as a player and as a coach. As a player he was named to the All-Olympic Conference and excelled in Track and Cross Country in addition to basketball.

Timbers returned to his alma mater in 1991, ten years after graduation, to become the Bulldog head men's basketball coach. From 1991-97 his teams garnered a 104-47 record. He led the team to a state championship in 1994 and earned the *Philadelphia Inquirer* Coach of the Year award following that season. His team also won the Conference title in 1994 and 1995.

As the GHS coach of cross country, Timbers helped his team achieve a 9-0 record in 1993. The team won the

conference championship that season and became the only undefeated Cross Country team in the history of Glassboro High School.

Timbers also coached track at Glassboro, and his team was the 1994 Group I Champion of the Woodbury Relays.


"I am honored to follow in the footsteps of my coach Steve Crispin," said Timbers, who lives in Glassboro.
