




VICTOR "CHUG" MANGENEY - '69

After graduation, Chug returned to the Glassboro sidelines and has missed very few games in the past 32 years. He's kept stats for the legendary Marv Slomsky, John Aveni, Bob Cleary and now for Herb Neilio.

He meticulously writes down yardage and tackles for every play. He rarely misses a game, no matter what the weather. Rain, monsoon, sleet, snow or bitter cold never keeps Chug from the sidelines.
