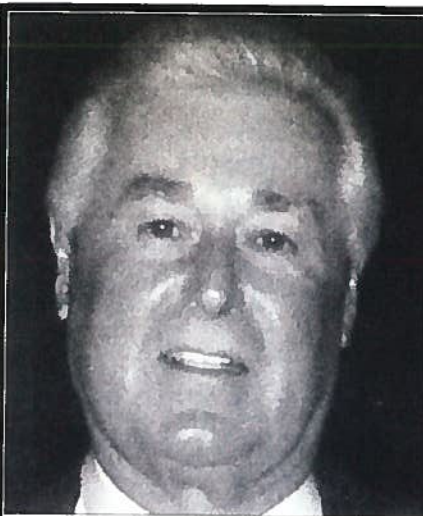

"Billy" Cioffi was captain of the GHS football Group I State Championship team in his senior year. He was named All Group I that year. He also earned 1st Team Olympic Conference and was a three-year Varsity Letter winner. As a wrestler, Bill was a member of the Olympic Conference Championship team for two years and of the South Jersey Group I Finalist team for three years. He was named 1st Team All-Olympic Conference for three years, 1st Team Group 1 (one year) and 2nd Team All South Jersey (one year). He was the three-time Christmas tournament Champion, the District 29 Champion and placed third in Region 8. His senior year record was 29-1. Bill also wrestled in college at Glassboro State, winning the Metropolitan Championship and Zone Championship each for three years. He was three times named 1st Team All-Conference and was a national qualifier for four years. He was named All American in 1988 and served as Captain of the wrestling team for two years. He was MVP of the Trenton National Qualifier for two years and racked up 100 college wins. He has coached wrestling at Glassboro, Clearview Regional and Pitman High Schools, coaching conference and state championship wrestlers and teams in all three schools. He and his wife Doris live in Pitman.

AUSTIN R. DATZ, JR. ~ '42

The late Austin Datz was a community man who dedicated his whole life to baseball and children. He and his late wife, Myrtle Carrey, lived in Mullica Hill. He enjoyed playing baseball, but enjoyed coaching little league even more. He valued teaching young children the fundamentals of the game. He played baseball at GHS and after graduation joined the Mullica Hill Semi-Pro team. He played briefly with the Chicago White Sox Minor League Team, but preferred to return to Mullica Hill where he could be close to his family and continue to coach. He was the first president of the Harrison Township Athletic Association and started Little League baseball in Harrison. He organized the Bi-County League for 13-15 year olds in 1969 and coached four teams to championship titles. Austin was a charter member of the Old Timers Club and served as Mayor of Harrison Township from 1992-95. Earlier this year, the Harrison Township Little League honored him by dedicating the Austin R. Datz Memorial Field House in his honor.

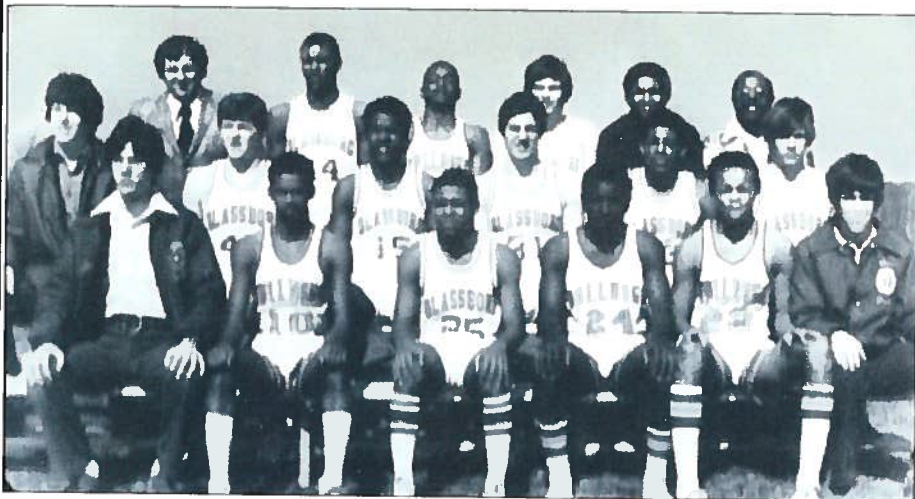

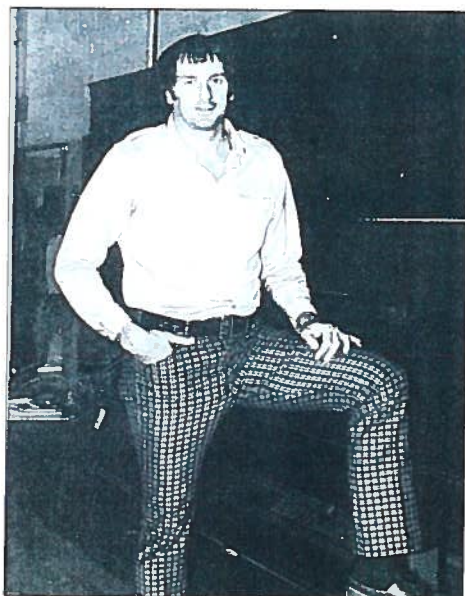

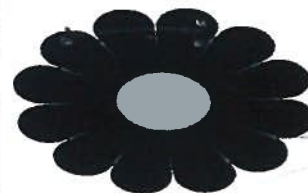
JOE MAZZEO ~ '84

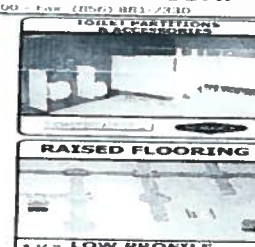

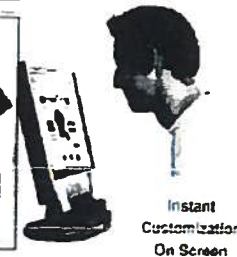
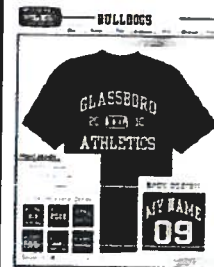
