

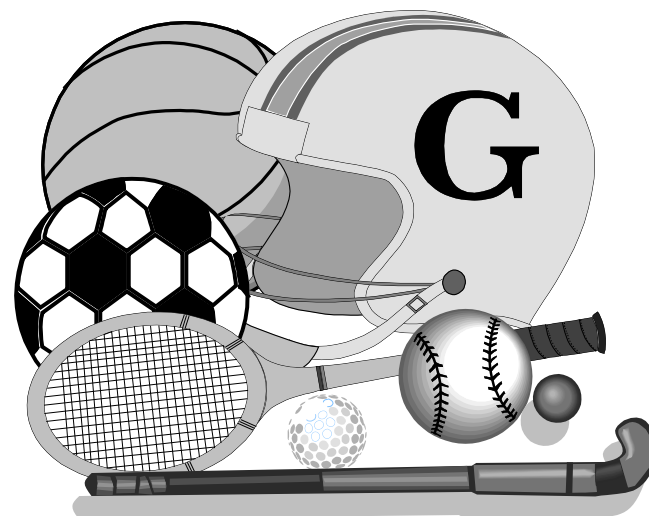

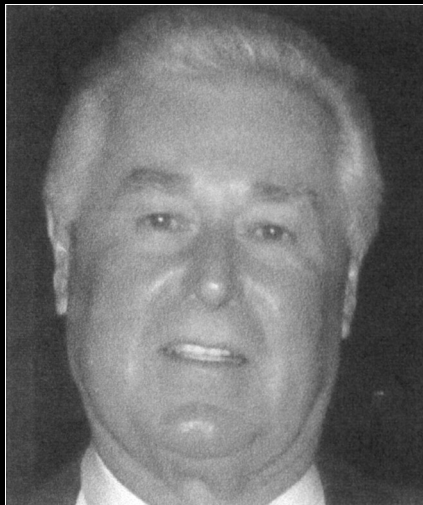

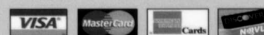

Frank graduated from Glassboro High School in 1950. He distinguished himself in football, wrestling and baseball during his high school athletic career.

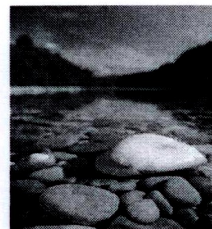

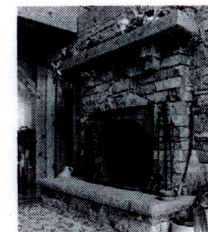

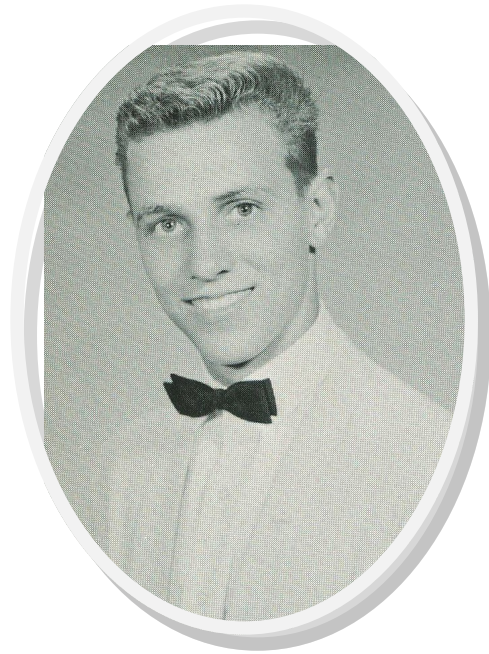
Bill graduated from Glassboro High School in 1964. He distinguished himself in football, wrestling and track & field during his high school athletic career.

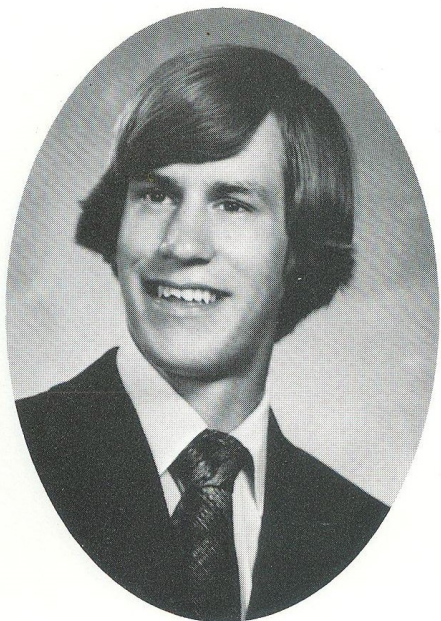
## **ROBERT L. CHESTER ~ '74**

Dan graduated from Glassboro High School in 1975. He distinguished himself in football, wrestling and baseball during his high school athletic career.

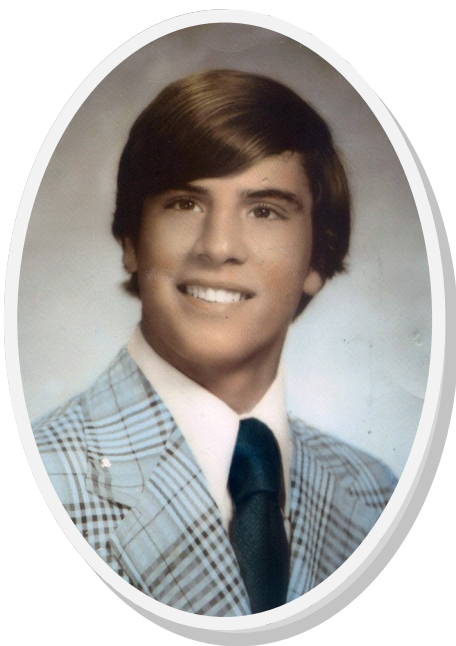

At graduation, Dan was the recipient of the St. Anthony's and the Walter Marshall Award Award.

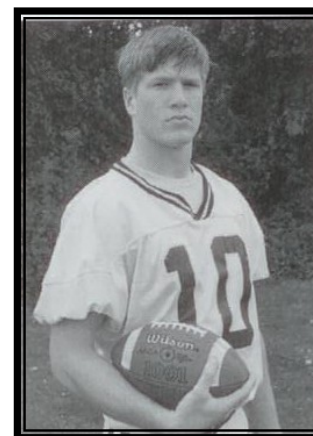

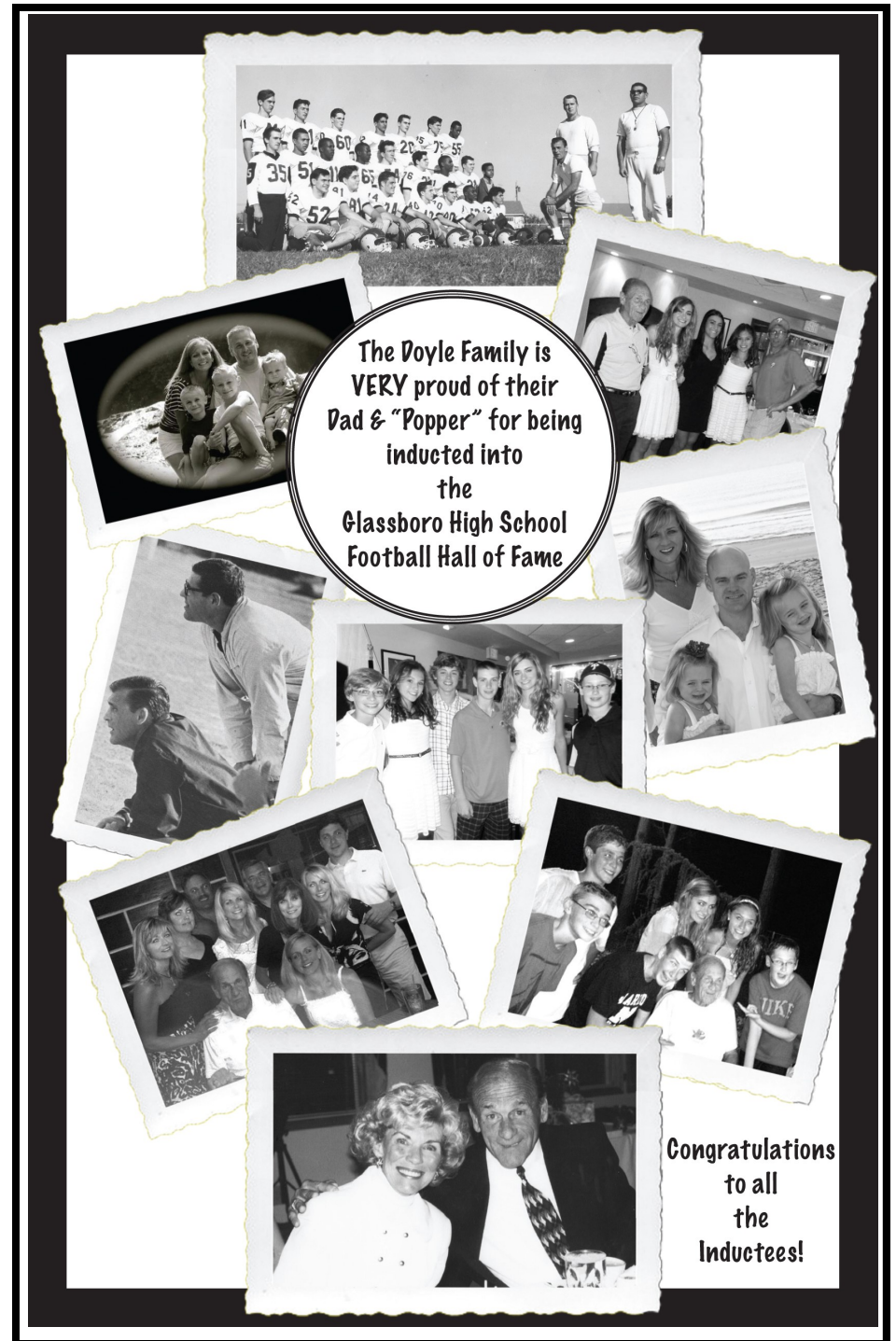
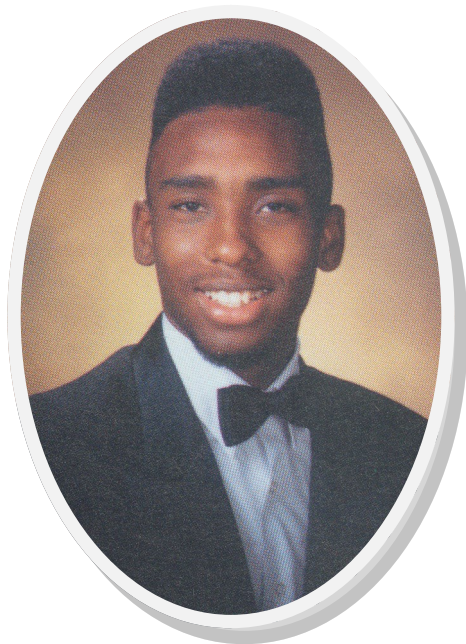
## **OZZIE SMITH-BEY ~' 92**

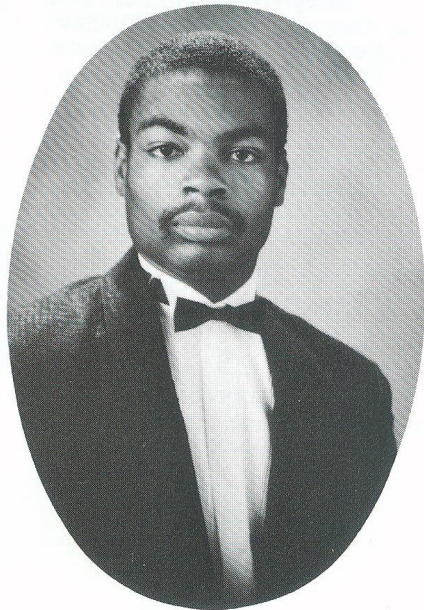

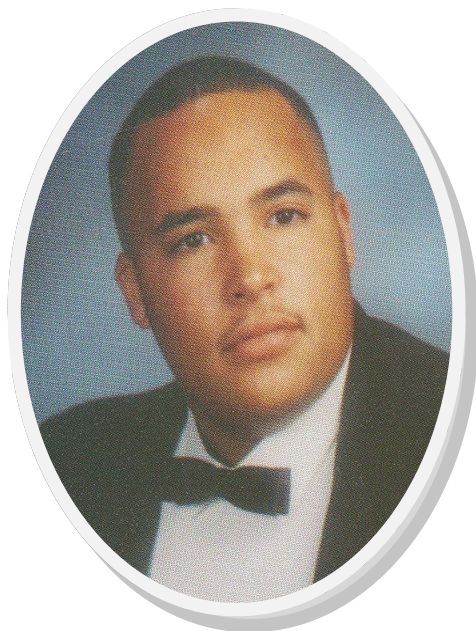
## **JUSTIN NEWELL ~ '97**
