- 4. Two (2) letters of reference from individuals familiar with the applicant's academic achievements, school involvement, and community service.
- 5. A copy of the applicant's official ACT or SAT scores, if applicable.
- 6. A copy of the applicant's official acceptance letter to the two-year accredited college or trade school that the applicant will attend.

**If chosen as a scholarship winner, the applicant MUST provide a copy of their fall 2025 semester course schedule AND a letter from the registrar's office on school letterhead showing enrollment for the fall 2025 semester.
