- 2. Explore Colleges, add colleges, notify school of colleges you have applied to, ask for letters of recommendation, View any scholarships that have been posted
- 3. Naviance Demo:
 - a. Remember your Student ID# and a password
 - Letters of recommendation: ask teacher/school staff in person to write you a letter of recommendation AND you will also need to request through Naviance.
 - c. Make sure to Match Naviance with your Common App!

FAFSA 2022-2023

- 1. FAFSA is free!
- 2. Even if you think your family may not be eligible for financial aid, you <u>need</u> to fill out the FAFSA form.
 - a. All colleges require this!
- 3. Senior Parent Night and Financial Aid Night
 - a. October 6, 2022 at 6 pm
 - b. GHS: Location TBD
- 4. Filing begins **October 1**:

- 5. Use taxes filed for 2020: yours or family

SAT/ACT

- 1. Average Score
 - a. See individual college or university requirements
- 2. If you are applying to apply to a 4-year college or university, December 2022 should be the last test date.

STARS Top 15 %

- 1. Students who are in the top 15% of their class at the end of junior year or senior year can attend RCGC for free tuition for 2 years.
- 2. Students have up to 2 years to decide to use this option
