



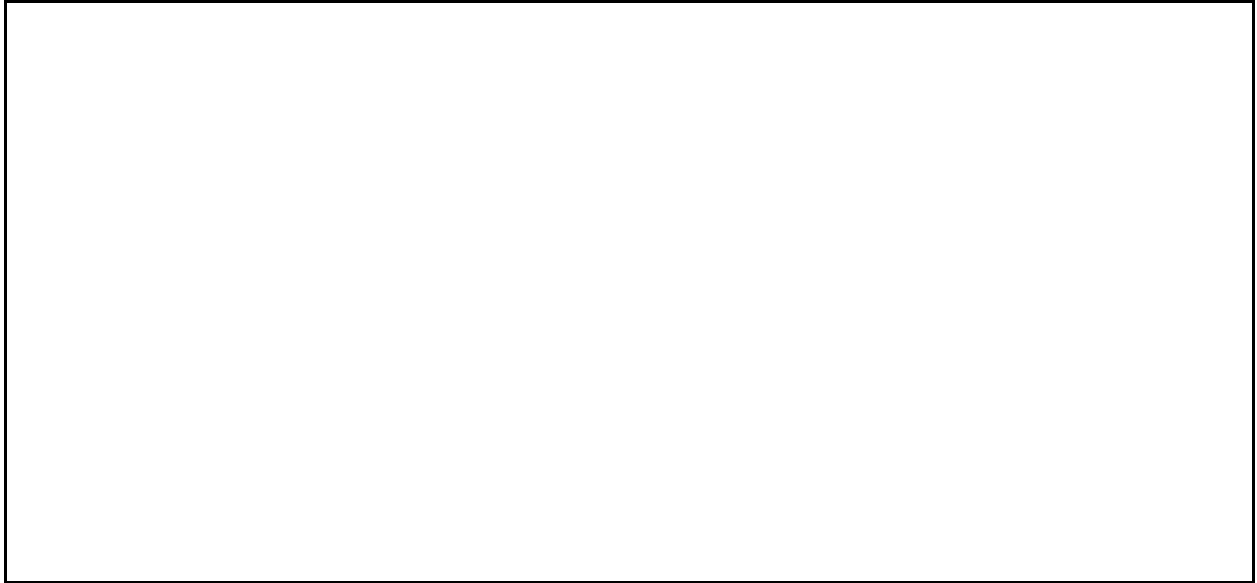




Day 3:

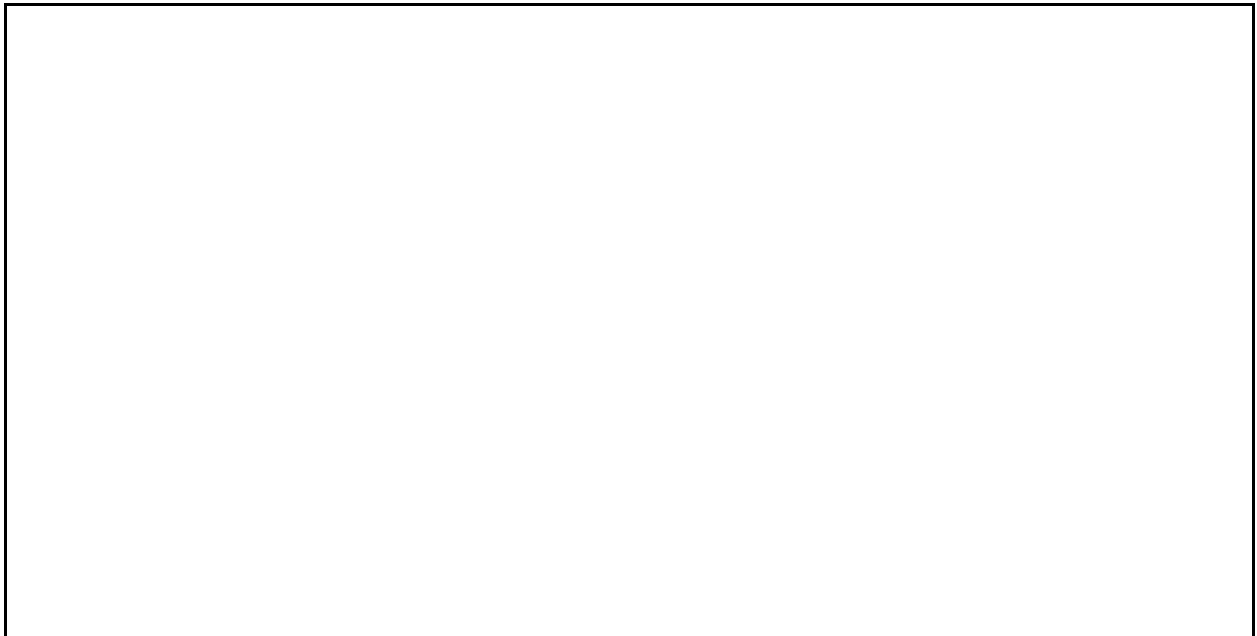
The first modern Olympics were held in Athens, Greece on April 6, 1986. There are so many different events in the Olympics. Which event would you add and why?
